KNIVES AND CUTTERS

Product choice guide

Choosing **knives**, **scissors** and **cutters** for warehouse, office and for general purpose

Our knives, scissors and cutters can be used in the warehouse and for general purpose. Here is a simple guide to understanding the difference.



Cutters -

The handle can be made from plastic or stainless steel, both are comfortable to hold and grip, there are 3 types of blades:

• Ceramic blades:

Blade is sharper and lasts longer, it can cut with more precision than steel but is fragile. It is a safer alternative cutter to use and does not rust. An ergonomic cutter is available.

Steel blades:

Blades are stronger and sharp, if worn can be replaced easily and at low cost.

• Sheet cutter: A simple disposable cutter with a metal blade, is low cost and safe to use.

Knives

- Raja knife: Universal. Everyday practical knife for office use and general work.
- Stanley knife: Ideal for intensive consistant work, and heavy duty.

Types of knives knives:

• Snap off:

The worn blade can be removed by 'snapping off' at the grooved intersection to allow use of the next sharp blade. There are ten blades per snap off knife.

• Retractable:

Blade slides in and out at the users control, blade 'clicks' when securely inside the holder. Standard heavy duty and heavy duty replacement blades available.

Scissors

Heavy duty scissors for the warehouse, the blade is sharper than the average office pair of scissors, with a longer blade for cutting larger items.
