### What does ISPM15 mean?

It is the International Standard for Phytosanitary Measures.

Its aim is to reduce the spread of destructive organisms from one continent to another. This standard is applicable for all wooden packaging thicker than 6 mm that is destined for countries outside of the European Community.

### How is this achieved?

The wood of packaging and pallets is fumigated in Methylene Bromide or treated at high temperature (56°C for 30 minutes).

All suitable packaging is then indelibly marked, in the form of a feather logo. The supplier takes responsibility that all his packaging conforms to this regulation.
